


We have an exciting yet challenging year ahead for the KirkWood children's choir:

We have a wonderful variety of music planned for the Fall, including 3 new pieces:


Heather Sorenson's new arrangement of "Cornerstone"

TEN GREAT REASONS TO TEACH SUNDAY SCHOOL


(especially Children's Ministry *hint hint*)



