## Clothing for the Homeless

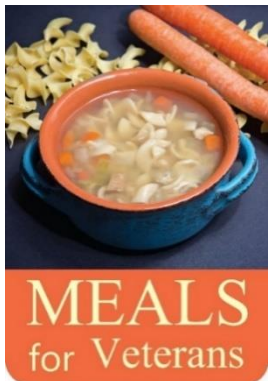
