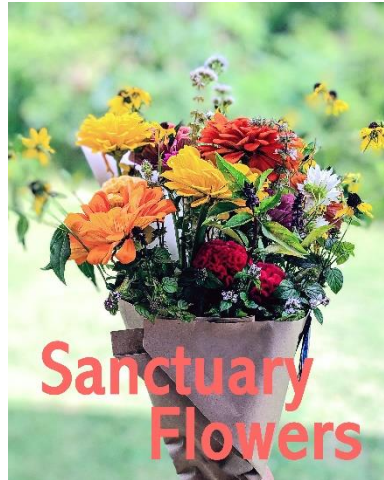


Prayer Requests and Special Needs

Chili Cook-off Almost Here!

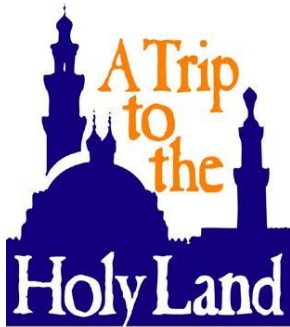
