

Ways to Be Intentional about Fellowship at KW During CoVid:

Here are some ways you can prioritize the spiritual habit or discipline of relationships, even during the remainder of the CoVid pandemic -

- 1. Would you like to be a part of a Zoom small group?** These would meet regularly for relationship-building, learning, prayer, etc. Typically, these groups meet twice a month; the duration would be till CoVid begins to wane (maybe 3-6 months). We're currently forming one new Zoom group, and could easily add another. Interested? Let the office or Pastor Chris know.
- 2. Would you like to gather with a small set of friends in our narthex?** We've got a brand new Keurig coffee machine in the narthex just waiting for your use. There would be a circle of chairs separated by six feet; masks are mandatory. Groups must be 10 or under. We'll be sure to decontaminate the space afterward. If you and your friends would like to gather together, just let the office or Pastor Chris know, and we'll reserve the space for you.
- 3. Would you like to learn about how to cultivate spiritual friendships in your life?** Do you have a desire to go deeper or get closer to a few friends here at KW? Would you like to develop a few kindred spirits, on whom you rely and with whom you share great openness and support, as a part of your own spiritual routine? We'd be glad to offer a seminar on that subject, and then help you get underway. Interested? Just let Pastor Chris know.

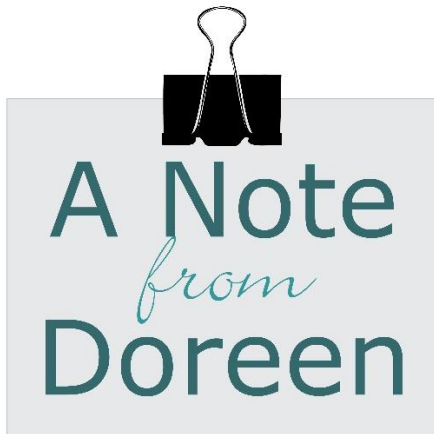
