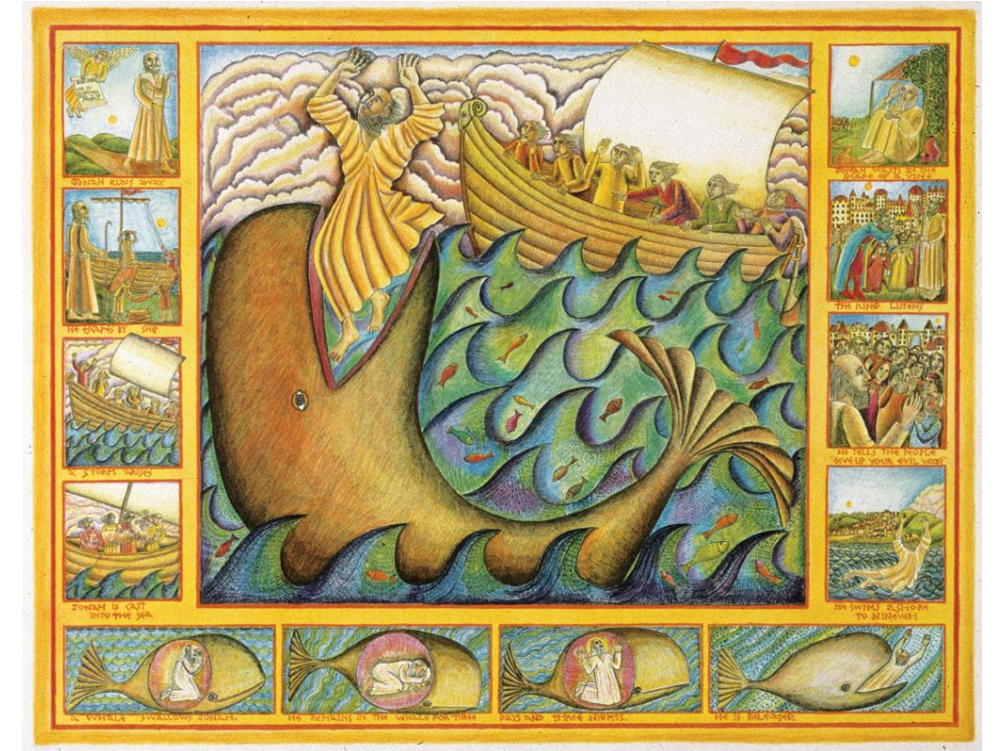


Prayer Requests and Special Needs

KYG (KirkWood Youth Group) will not meet for the month of February.

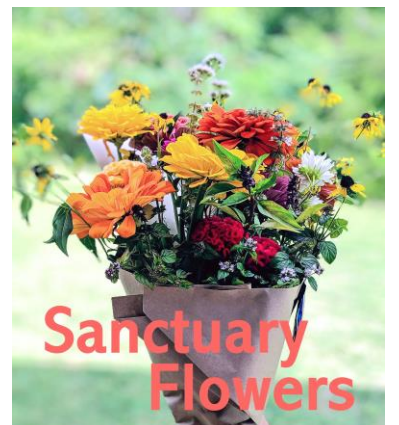

New Members Class?

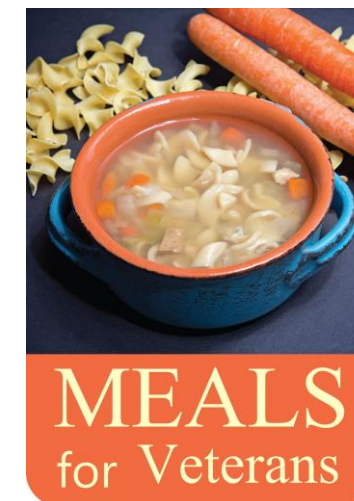
