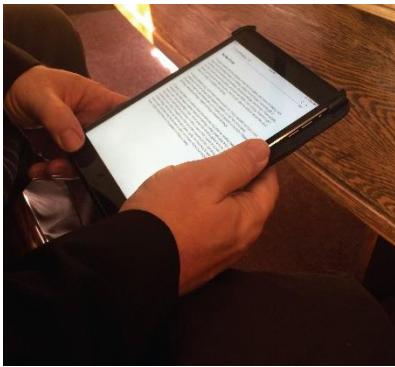

Dear KirkWood family,

As the Chartered Organization Representative, I would like to convey how proud I am of both our Troop 54 Boy Scouts and Cub Scouts. We hear over and over again how "unprecedented" this past year has been, but these leaders and Scouts have risen to the challenge of being able to hold their Troops together, no matter what has been thrown at them. They have mastered meetings via virtual ZOOM, in person (less than 25), the parking lot, other outdoor activities, even virtual campouts and virtual visits to museums and zoos! All of these were done with the focus of being a part of the Scout experiences. This past week, even a virtual Pinewood Derby was held! Boards of review have continued to be held and advancements did not stop. Seven Boy Scouts even entered the all-exclusive rank of Eagle! Since its inception in 1911, only four percent of Scouts have earned this rank after a lengthy review process. We also had another popcorn/peanut sale this year. We had \$55,000 in total sales which raised \$21,000 for the scouts and the troop. For just the popcorn amount, Troop 54 ranked in the top 25 units in the nation this year.

We also have 15 Scouts (2 from other troops) and 8 leaders making up 2 Crews who are led by a youth Crew Leader for each crew who will be leaving for Philmont Scout Ranch on 24 June and return 10 July. They will spend 12 nights camping in the Sangre de Cristo Mountains (lower Rockies) and backpack about 70 miles. This is considered a Capstone Event in Scouting and the Adventure of a Lifetime...no Scout who attends returns the same as when they left, they grow and become a better stronger version of their former selves!

So, you can see that the Scouts have been very busy, in spite of a lot of roadblocks in the Scouting journey. They ALL continue to practice the Scout Motto of "Be prepared" no matter what!

Thank you for making KirkWood their "home."
