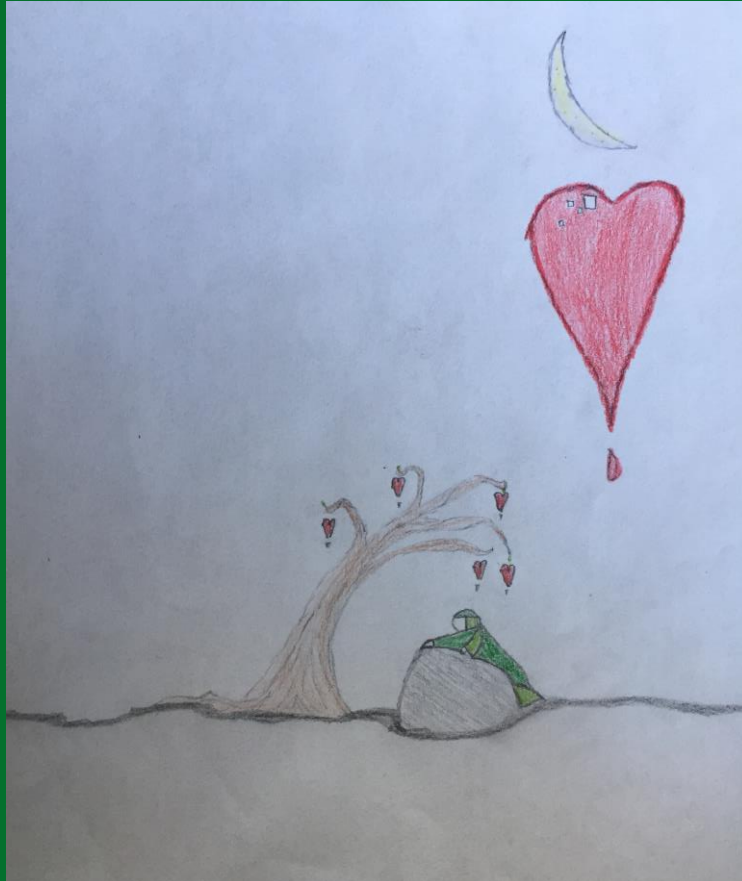

- 3) Meetings Any Other Time: Of course, if neither of the above time slots work for your schedule, Chris is happy to meet or Zoom with you anytime, or talk on the phone if that's more convenient. Just reach out to him, and he'll get you on his schedule ASAP.

Our Youth Director, Ashley Wenner, has recently informed KirkWood that she's feeling called by God to another kind of ministry, and will be leaving her post here on 5/30/21. We are so grateful to Ashley for her wonderful ministry among us and look forward to hearing how God uses her elsewhere and in new ways. We'll be sure to give her a heartfelt send-off before her last day with us.



Sunday Zoom Coffee Fellowship: We'll have a Zoom coffee fellowship time between the end of the worship service (10:30ish) and the start of the adult Zoom Sunday School class (11:00). Come hang out and chat for as little or as long as you'd like during this 30 min. window. The Zoom link was sent to you in the Midweek Minute weekly email.



Here's some great news! After ongoing monitoring of the CoVid pandemic and careful consideration, KW's Session has approved reopening for in-person worship services. These services will look like what we were doing between July and November of 2020: masks will be mandatory, family units will be spaced out around the sanctuary, we'll offer overflow seating in the Fellowship Hall, etc. Our 1st Sunday back in the building will be April 4th, Easter Sunday. Post-Easter, we'll be offering 9:30 and 11:00 services; on Easter, we'll offer a 3rd early service with the time to be determined.

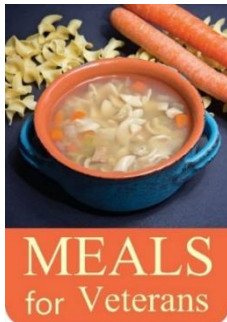

We've got another Zoom Sunday evening series debriefing with Pastor Chris scheduled on 3/28 from 7:00-7:45 p.m. Unlike the Monday Rendezvous, which is basically an open forum, these debriefings are meant to help you work through your experimentation with the various spiritual disciplines covered in this series. Drop in to ask a question, talk about your experience, etc.; you don't have to stay the whole 45 min. The Zoom link/info will be in the 3/25 Midweek Minute, and posted on Kirkwood's Facebook page.

Soon the P&F committee will be looking for volunteers to be part of a summer lawn mowing team to help keep the KirkWood campus looking its best.
