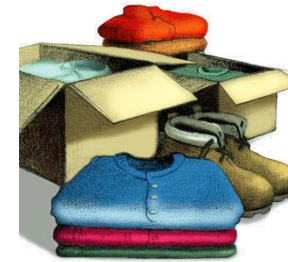

**KirkWood Silver** – April trip to Endview Plantation in Lee Hall has been cancelled because of the Governor's announcement on March 23.


