Worship

Sunday In-Person Worship - 1st Phase:

As we reopen for in-person Sunday worship, here are some things to keep in mind -

- a) 9:30 will be our Praise and Worship Service, and 11:00 will be our Liturgical Worship Service. So the worship band will be leading the 9:30 service with mostly contemporary worship music, while we'll have more hymns, piano, and choir music at 11:00.
- b) However, we'll be trying to keep in place the creativity and collaboration that we've cultivated during COVID, so expect that some liturgy and special music will be shared at both services.
- c) We'll also be trying to continue our thematic worship services, in which the entire service and all its elements focus on one topic, which also means the worship order will vary week to week.
- d) We will live stream the 9:30 worship service via YouTube; for logistical reasons, we can't really live stream both services.
- e) When we're able to restart congregational singing, we'll step back and reconsider these guidelines.
- f) Last, we will continue to livestream the 9:30 worship service on YouTube each Sunday, so that we can engage those not ready to return to in-person worship and/or those who are a part of the KW family but not in our area.

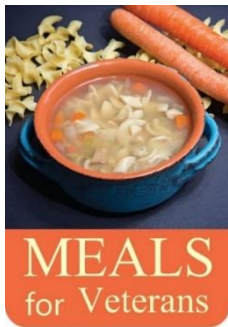
