It's Sunday morning and someone cheerfully greets you at the door at KirkWood. Then before you enter the sanctuary, another person greets you and hands you a bulletin. What a great way to meet members and visitors at KirkWood. We are once again looking for additional greeters/ushers to help us in the coming months.

Each Sunday, there are 2-person greeter/usher teams. These folks arrive no later than 30 minutes before service. They make sure that doors are unlocked, and lights are on in the narthex and that everything is properly prepared in the sanctuary. They greet folks as they arrive, hand out bulletins and assist folks that need help with seating. They keep a weekly count of folks in the sanctuary, and then clean up, lock doors, and turn off the lights.
