2nd Thursday Free Lunches First Presbyterian Church, Hampton

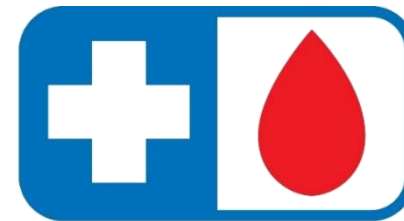
