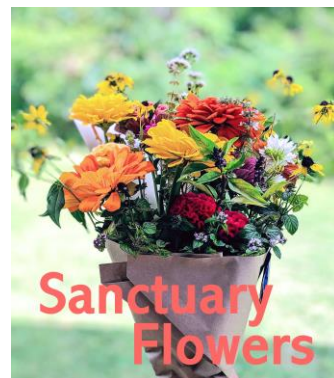
2) Join us tomorrow evening on Zoom at 7 PM to pray for our neighbors and world. The link will be in the Monday Memo email tomorrow.
