Women's retreat

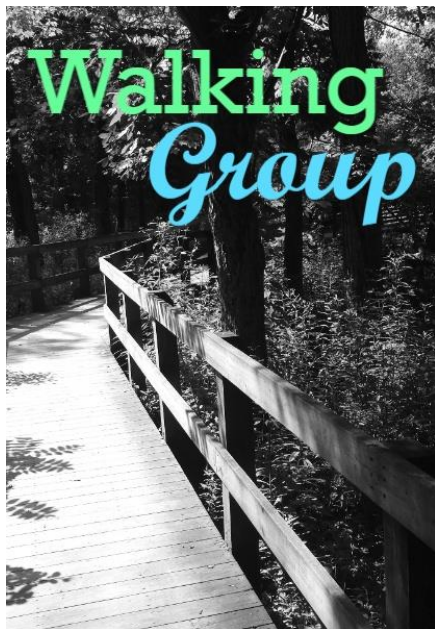
