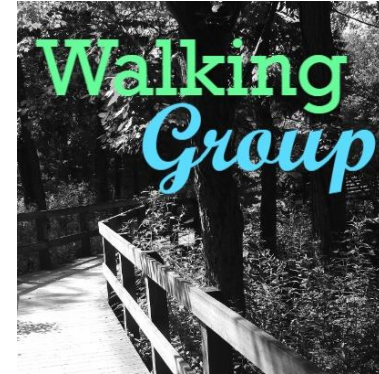

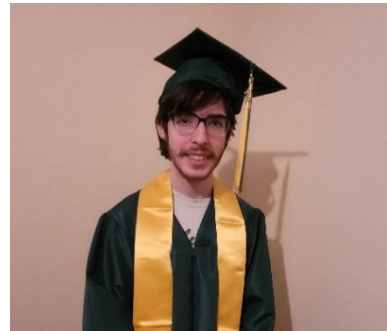

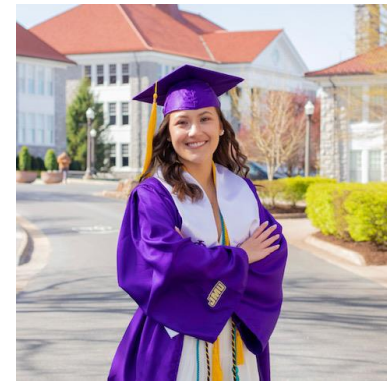
OUR COLLEGE GRADUATES!
