Food Collection Event



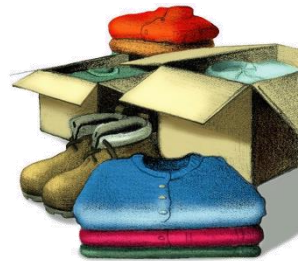
