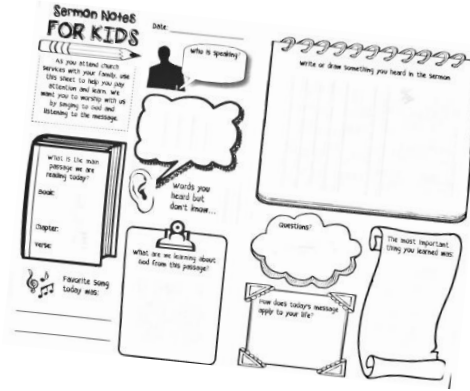
- 7/9 - Series introductory message: Why a series like this REALLY matters

Little Free Food Pantry

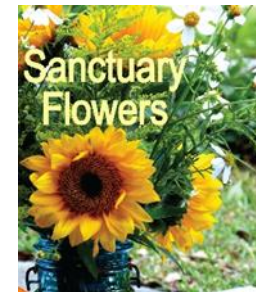
