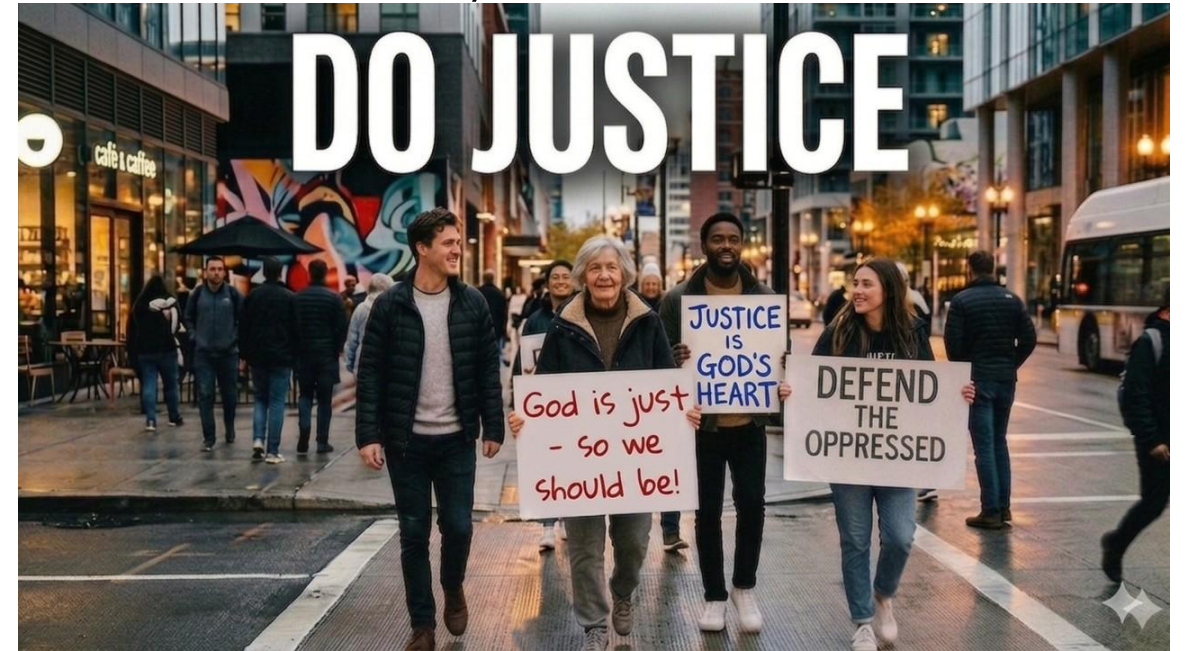

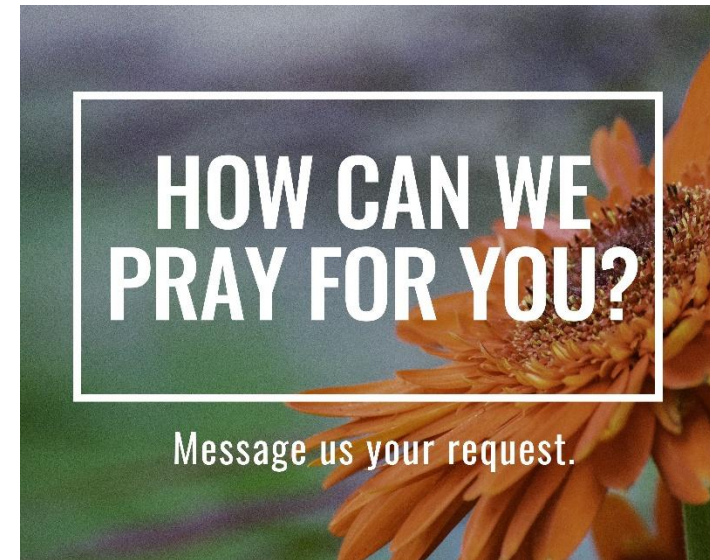

Support for Migrant Farm Workers - The Mission Committee would like to participate in PEVA's annual migrant workers program. This program provides much needed food and clothing for the migrant workers who arrive on the Eastern Shore (part of PEVA's area) in August to harvest crops. We invite you to make a donation. There are number of ways you can donate.

1. Donate any amount you choose. (Make checks out to KirkWood and put "Migrant Workers" on the memo line or scan the QR code to donate online at <https://secure.myvanco.com/L-7213/campaign/C-16EWR>.)
2. Donate \$25 for a food kit that PEVA puts together. (Again, pay by check or online).
3. Donations of summer clothing for children aged newborn and up (used is fine), disposable diapers (newborn to size 7), and baby wipes.
4. Men's and women's clothing: jeans and t-shirts(S-XL), hats, and sunscreen. Look for a bin in the sanctuary in which to place items. Donations are needed by next Sunday, July 5 in order to get funds to PEVA.
