Dr. Willis is the "Digital Pastor" and founder of the Digital Worship Center which offers weekly broadcasts on Facebook and Periscope.

This summer we are not offering VBS for all ages as usual, however we will be offering a Middle School VBS program for up to 10 participants. There will be a waiting list available for additional participants.


