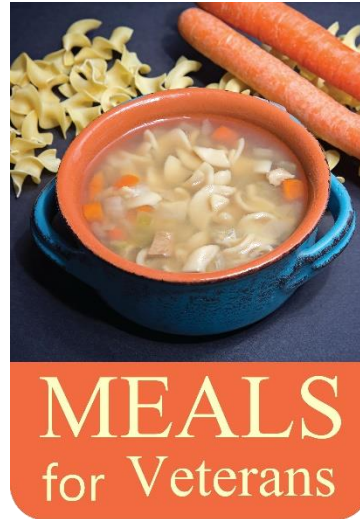


KirkWood Youth Group (KYG) will start back up tonight 5 – 6:30pm.

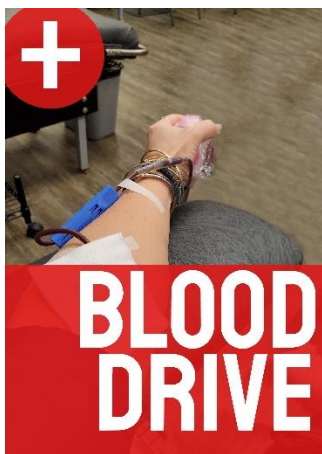


Possible Trip to the Holy Land in 2023?
