## Food Collection Update

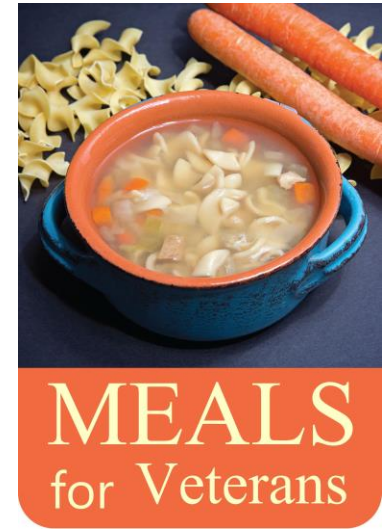
