Our first delivery date is Saturday, October 3rd. We are hard at work to create the safest Patch possible this year for our visitors, but also for "you" our volunteers. We are partnering with others in the congregation who guided our church opening to help assure proper distancing and cleaning efforts, and we welcome your feedback.

The truck unloading will look a bit different as we'll be using a forklift to unload the pumpkins (which will be shipped in bins) and volunteers will then place them in the Patch.
