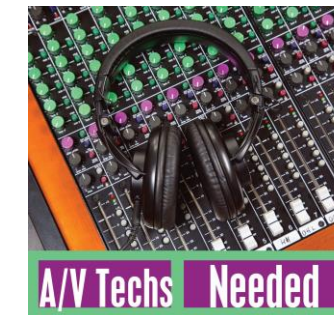
2021 Pumpkin Patch
