

Habitat for Humanity is having another home blitz repair day for homes in the Buckroe area of Hampton on November 15th. This is a single-day event in which 8-20 homes in a designated neighborhood receive exterior home repairs for a nominal fee and anywhere from 100-300 volunteers.
