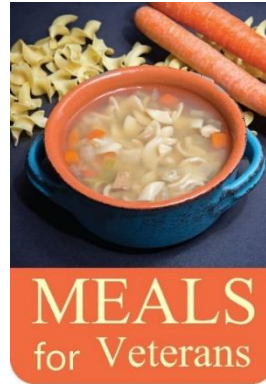

The **Fall Clean Up and Pumpkin Patch Removal Day** is November 7th from 8 to 11am (but usually completed by 10am). If you are able to help, we will be trimming trees, raking leaves, general grounds maintenance, and removing the entire pumpkin patch. We would love to have you for whatever time you can afford, either the entire time or even one hour. Bring a rake, gloves, wheelbarrow, etc.

We are in the process of continuing the **remodeling of the church**. The painting of the hallways is complete and now it is time to replace the flooring. We will also update and re-hang the bulletin boards. We can use all levels of talent. Here are the planned days for replacing the flooring:

- 11/9 - 8am to 1pm: Remove carpet in hallways and start painting the trim on bulletin boards
- 11/10 - 3pm to 8pm: Complete removal and start installing flooring and continue painting the trim on bulletin boards
- 11/11 - 8am to 1pm: Continue installing flooring and continue painting the trim on bulletin boards
- 11/12 - 3pm to 8pm: Continue installing flooring
- 11/13 - 8am to 1pm: Continue installing flooring
- 11/16 - 8am to 1pm: Install trim and hanging bulletin boards
- 11/17 - 3pm to 8pm: Install trim and hanging bulletin boards
- 11/18 - 8am to 1pm: Install trim and hanging bulletin boards
