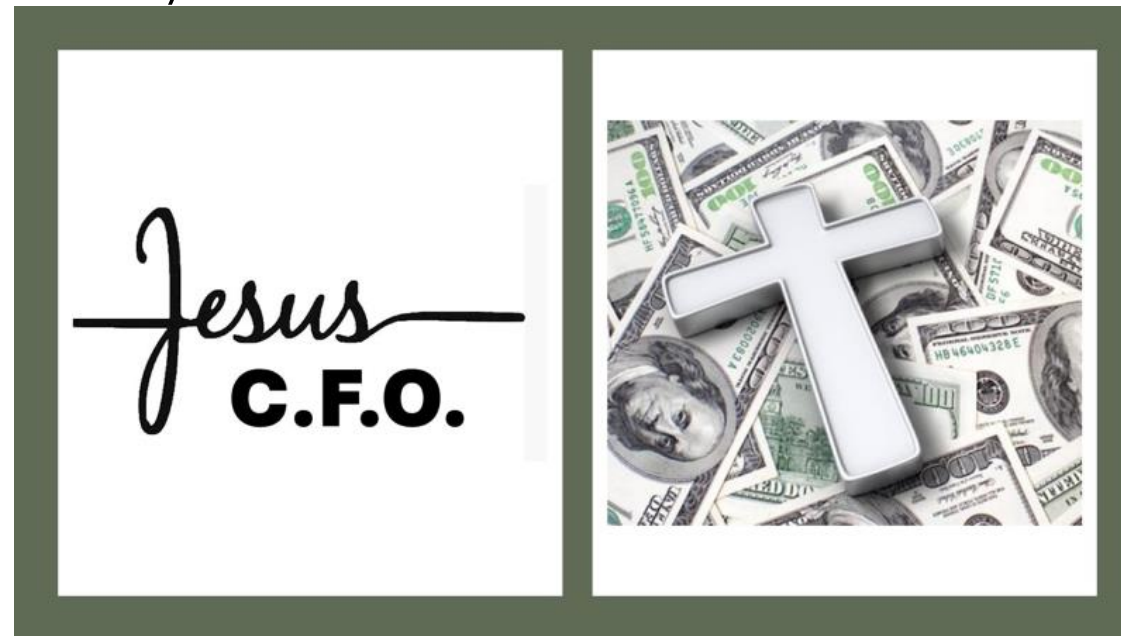

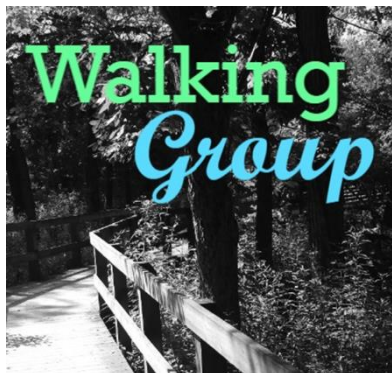


Prayer Requests and Special Needs

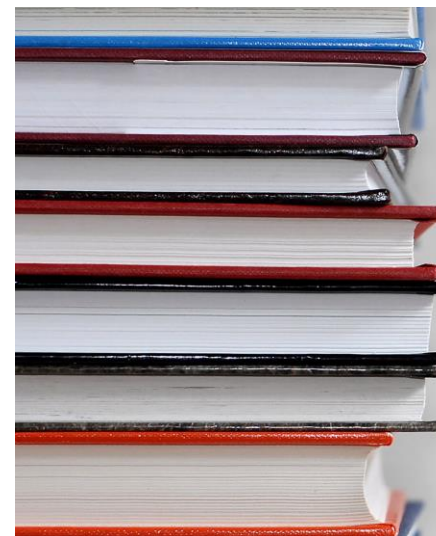
