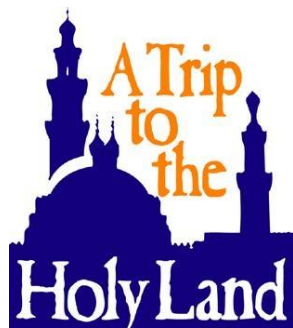

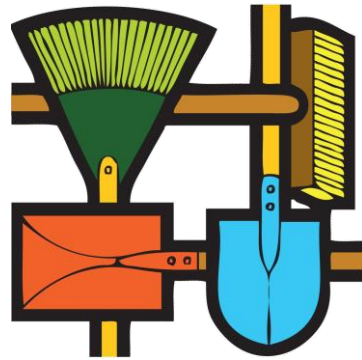


PORT (People Offering Resources Together)
