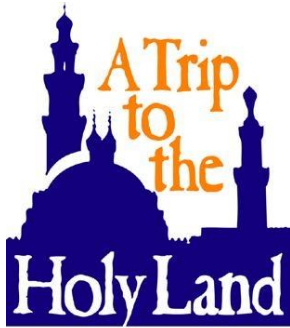

BLOOD DRIVE

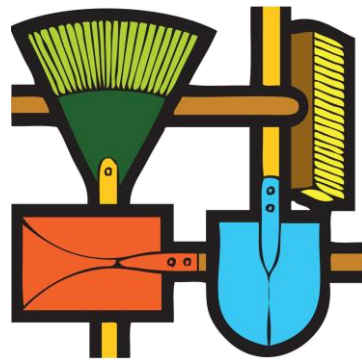
