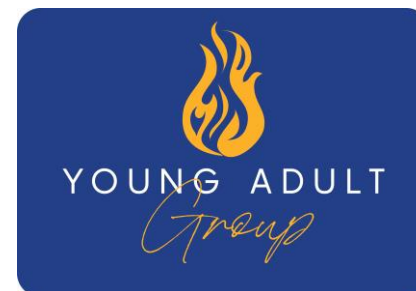
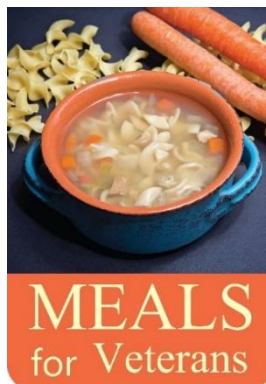
Clothing for the Homeless
